
Step-by-step flow for application, exam, and onboarding

- Non-Engineering programs: No mandatory subject. Maths is a desirable subject.

- B. Com and B. Sc. Economics (Data Science)

Application Fee is non-Refundable & non-Transferable

- Only 1 Application allowed for each TYPE of Application.
- ➤ If an Applicant wishes to apply for both Engineering & non-Engineering courses, it can be done by submitting one Application for each TYPE for taking 2 separate SNUCEEs by booking two separate SNUCEE Slots.
- Each Application will be treated differently, and Application Fee will be payable for each application submitted. The Entrance Exam & Admission Process for each Application is independent.
- Application started for any TYPE should be completed and submitted. System will not allow starting a fresh Application for the same TYPE and will show a message "Duplicate Aadhaar Number" or "Duplicate Passport Number".
- The email-id & mobile number used to start an application are the registered contact details for the Application and must be used for all communication. Mails received from un-Registered email-ids will not be responded to.
- This Information Brochure & the SNUC website provide all information regarding the Admissions Process at Shiv Nadar University Chennai. Responses will be given ONLY to queries on information not available therein.
- Please read the complete Information Sheet before you start filling up the Application.

Admissions Process

- 1. All admissions to SNU Chennai are purely merit based and no other criteria is applicable or accepted.
- 2. Applicants are prohibited from approaching anybody at the University for soliciting Admissions. Any violation will lead to immediate disqualification of the Applicant.
- 3. For B. Com., B. Com. (Professional Accounting) and B. Sc. Economics (Date Science) Programs, admissions are basis performance in the Entrance Exam, SNUCEE.
- 4. For B Tech Programs, there are two tracks for admission to SNU Chennai:
 - a. Through Entrance Examination **SNUCEE**
 - b. Basis JEE Mains Score
- 5. SNUC does not accept the scores of any other Exams, e.g. SAT.
- 6. Admissions Process:

SNUCEE Score / JEE Mains Score → Shortlist for Personal Interview → Shortlist for Provisional Admissions Offer

Eligibility Criteria

- 10th Standard School Board Marks: Only students with minimum 60% Marks in aggregate are eligible to apply.
- 12th Standard School Board Marks: Only students with minimum
 75% Marks in aggregate are eligible for admissions.

NOTE: Marks below the minimum requirement cannot be rounded off to be shown as 60% or 75% achievement.

- Applicants from School Boards which provide Grade / GPA based results will have to furnish the marks in equivalent %. For conversion from Grades to %, methodology / direction provided by the School Board must be used.
- Applicants, whose 12th Standard results are expected to be delayed beyond May 2026 will have to provide Predicted Marksheet from their School. Admission may be considered basis Predicted Marks; however, if actual Marks are not minimum 75% in aggregate once results are declared, the provisional Admission Offer will be withdrawn.

- 1. There are 2 separate Forms for Engineering & non-Engineering Applications :
 - a. Form for 12 nos. B. Tech. programs
 - b. Form for B.Com, B.Com. (Professional Accounting) *and* B. Sc. Economics (Data Science) Programs
- 2. All mandatory fields of the Application Form must be filled & all mandatory documents uploaded for Form to be accepted.
- 3. B. Tech. Application assigning preference nos. to Programs:
 - a. SNU Chennai Offers 12 nos. B. Tech. Programs.
 - **b.** Applicant must assign a priority number to ALL the 12 programs on offer. This is a mandatory requirement.
- 4. B. Com. & B. Sc. Application assigning preference nos. to Programs:
 - a. SNU Chennai offers B.Com., B.Com. (Professional Accounting) and B.Sc. Economics (Data Science) Programs through the same Application.
 - **b.** Applicant must assign a priority number to ALL the 3 programs on offer. This is a mandatory requirement.



Application Categories

Applicants are required to apply in one of the following categories:

- 1. General
- 2. NRI: One parent must have a valid NRI status.
- 3. OCI / PIO / Foreign National: non-Indian Nationality of the Applicant.
- **4. SPORTS**: For students with outstanding achievements in the field of sports at National or International level *ONLY during 2024 & 2025*.
- 5. EXTRA CURRICULAR: For students with outstanding recognition of skills at National or International level *ONLY during* 2024 & 2025.
- **6. Vidyagyan**: Students from Vidyagyan schools must apply under this category.

7. NOTE

- a. NRI & PIO / OCI / Foreign National categories: While there is no "quota", Applicants in these categories who are shortlisted basis performance in SNUCEE are considered as a separate group for further processes.
- **b.** Sports & Extra-Curricular categories: Applicants shortlisted for the Interview stage are awarded additional marks, depending on the excellence of their achievement / recognition.

Application Process

- Applicant will be able to complete the Application Form only after filling up all the mandatory fields & uploading all the mandatory documents.
- The Registered Email-id & Registered Mobile No. cannot be changed.
- The Aadhaar No. / Passport No. can be used for ONLY ONE Application for any TYPE of Application. Applicants found applying under an Aadhaar No. / Passport No. that does not belong them would be immediately barred from further processes.
- Applicant can choose to apply for both Engineering & non-Engineering Programs by filling up both TYPES of Forms.
 - Two (2) separate Applications will have to be submitted, two (2)
 Application Fees will have to be paid & two (2) SNUCEEs have to be taken in different Exam Slots.
 - Evaluation for the two (2) Applications will be done separately.
- Application Editing: Select fields of the Application will be accessible after submission for correcting errors
 - Non-Editable Fields: Category of Application / Community / Priority of Program preference / Aadhaar Number or Passport No. / Email-id & Mobile No.




SNUCEE Slot Booking

- SNUCEE slots are available on "1st come 1st booked" basis.
- Exam Hall Capacities for all Exam Slots are fixed. Hall Capacities cannot be increased.
- Slot can be booked only from the options displayed at the time of Slot Booking.
- SNUCEE Slot Booking is a fully automated, system defined process.
- Slot Booking must be done directly by the Applicant. SNUC cannot assist / intervene in this matter.
- Once all mandatory fields have been filled up, the Applicant will be directed to the Dashboard for Slot Booking (City, Date and Time Slot).
- Once Slot is booked, the Applicant will be directed to the Dashboard for payment of Application Fee.
- For the Slot to be confirmed, Application Fee must be paid within 15 minutes of Slot Booking.
- If Application Fee Payment is not paid within 15 minutes, the Slot booked will be automatically cancelled. The Applicant will then have to go the Dashboard again to re-book the slot and pay the Application Fee.

SNUCEE SLOT ONCE BOOKED, CANNOT BE CHANGED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, even if later the timing conflicts with the Entrance Exam of any other Institute.

- ALL Applicants, MUST book a SNUCEE Slot and Pay the Application Fee for the Application to be valid.
- SNUCEE Slot must be booked, and Application Fee must be paid even by Applicants who wish to be considered for Interview only basis their JEE Mains Score and do not wish to take the SNUCEE (Only JEE Mains score of minimum 90 is considered for Interview shortlisting)

While SNUCEE is not mandatory for candidates who wish to be considered for Interview basis their JEE Mains score only, we strongly recommend that they too take the SNUCEE, in order to maximize their chances of getting shortlisted for the Interview stage as very few seats are assigned to the JEE track.

- SNUCEE is a Computer based MCQ Exam, with negative marks for wrong answers..
- SNUCEE can be taken only at one of the designated Exam Centers.
- There is no provision for taking the SNUCEE outside a designated Exam Centre, or in an Online mode.

Interview Process & Tentative Schedule...

Applicants for the Interview Stage are selected on basis performance in SNUCEE or basis JEE Mains Score

- Shortlist for each Interview stage is prepared after a set of 2-3 SNUCEE Phases.
- Shortlist for Interview Phases will be arrived at basis the performance of all applicants in the SNUCEE phases under consideration for the corresponding Interview Phase.
- SNUC does not publish the list of Applicants selected for Interviews. The successful candidates are sent the Interview Call letters directly on their Registered email-ids.
- SNUC will not be able to comment on the status of individual Applicants and will not respond to queries on the status of Interview Call of individual applicants.
- ALL Applicants called for Interview must be present at the Campus as per the schedule given in the Interview Call letters. No change in interview date or slot will be entertained.
- SNUC may decide to conduct ONLINE Interview for some candidates at its sole discretion.
- SNUC will not entertain any requests to change in-person Interview mode to Online mode, irrespective of the reason behind the request.
- Conflict with any other Exam or any other Interview will not be a reason for Interview Date/ Slot change.
- Interviews basis JEE Mains score is normally scheduled AFTER JEE Advanced results have been declared.

Provisional Admission Offer...

- After each Interview Phase a **shortlist** is prepared performances in the Interviews.
- A Ranking List of the above Shortlisted candidates is prepared after the Interview, basis SNUCEE / JEE Mains score, 12th Standard Marks & Interview score.
- Applicants will be offered a Program as per their Preference priority, subject to their Rank in the Ranking List.
- SNUC does not publish the list of Applicants who are shortlisted for Provisional Admission Offers. The successful candidates are sent the Offer letter on their Registered email-ids.
- Offer Letters are e-mailed within 10 days of Interview date.
- SNUC will not respond to queries on the status of individual Applicants who
 have appeared for the Interview Phases.





Provisional Admission Offer acceptance...

Provisional Admission Offers are made basis:

- 1. Program Preference Priority in the Application Form
- 2. Rank of the student in the Ranking List

For the seat to be blocked:

- The ERP Fields provided through a link in the Offer Letter must be filled up in full.
- Program offered in the Provisional Admission Offer Letter must be accepted.
- Full Fees must be paid by the due date mentioned in the Offer Letter.
- Sliding request to a different Program may be put in by submitting the Sliding Request Form through a link provided in the Offer Letter Sliding is system driven and will depend on the Rank in the Ranking List and the availability of seats in the requested Program.
- Sliding requests are considered ONLY from Applicants who have accepted the Program offered and have made the Full Fee payment within the due date.
- Once sliding is triggered, the Applicant will be kept informed over email to the registered email-id.
- SNUC will not respond to any query regarding status of a sliding request.





Fee Payment...

Provisional Admission Offer will remain valid only if Full Fees, as given in the Offer Letter is paid within the deadline mentioned in the letter.

- Full Fees includes University Fees and either Hostel Fee or Transport Fee (as applicable) and these must be paid in full by the due date mentioned in the Offer Letter.
- The Full Fee payment deadline is normally within 7 days from the date of the Offer Letter. NO EXTENSION OF FULL FEE PAYMENT DEADLINE IS POSSIBLE.
- If Full Fee payment is not made within the specified deadline, the Provisional Offer Letter stands automatically withdrawn and the seat is offered to the next eligible applicant in the shortlist.
- SNUC does not send any reminders for making the Full Fee payment.
- Partially paid Fees will be refunded after completion of the entire Admissions process for AY 2026-27.
- Fee Payment receipts are generated immediately after the Fees have been paid. Please download and save copies of the receipts. These will be required at various stages of the admissions process.
- Receipt of Fees paid in Full is a confirmation of Admission seat being blocked for the student. No separate acknowledgement is sent.





- Hostel Room Allocation
- Transport Facility



- > Opting for either Hostel or Transport and paying the applicable Fee is mandatory.
- > FULL FEE PAYMENT means University Fee + Hostel or Transport Fee.
- > There are no exceptions to this requirement.

Admission Seat will not be blocked if FEE payment is not done in FULL by due date

Hostel Room Allocation

- Hostel Room allocation is on 1st-cum-1st-allocated basis.
- 1st Year students are offered ONLY shared AC or non-AC Rooms.
- Priority for Hostel Room is given to Outstation students.
- Allocation of Hostel Room to students from the Chennai is subject to availability, after allocation to Outstation students has been completed.
- In case a student has paid the Hostel Fees but is not allotted a Room, the Hostel Fee will be converted to Transport Fee and excess Fee, if any, will be refunded.
- The number of AC Rooms is limited. In case a student is allotted a non-AC Room, despite having paid the Fee for an AC Room, the excess Hostel Room Rent will be refunded.

Students can take up their hostel room immediately after completing the Verification of Original Documents, and before the date of Commencement of classes.

Transport Facility

- SNUC has ~ 50 Air-Conditioned buses to transport students to Campus & back.
- The bus routes cover entire Chennai, and students would be able to access the University Transport within a short distance from their homes.
- The timings of the buses from different locations are designed to ensure that all buses reach the Campus by around 7.45am.
- Buses leave the Campus at 3.50 4.00pm, after classes end.




Verification of Original Documents

- All admissions remain provisional, pending physical verification of Original Documents.
- Any discrepancy between the details in the Original Documents and details submitted by the student may result in withdrawal of admission offer.
- The date and time slot for Document Verification will be informed to the students at least 7 days before the actual date.
- Presence of the student with ONE (1) Parent is mandatory.
- Tentative schedule for Document Verification
 - \circ B. Com. & B. Sc. Programs : 1st / 2nd week of July 2026
 - o B. Tech.: 2nd / 3rd week of August 2026
- The above schedule is subject to change at the discretion of SNUC.

"Shubharambham" - Orientation Program

- The occasion is also used to share very important information by Faculty members that will familiarize the students with Academic activities.

Fee Refund Policy...

- Fee Refund Policy applies only to Fees paid in Full for blocking seat for a Program. *Partially paid Fees will be refunded AFTER conclusion of all Admissions for AY 2026-27.*
- SNU Chennai's Fee Refund Policy will be in line with the UGC Guidelines applicable at the time of the Admissions withdrawal request

Fee Refund Process

- Applicant to request Withdrawal & Fee Refund via a mail to <u>admissions@snuchennai.edu.in</u> from the registered email-id.
- In response, a Refund Request Form will be mailed via a Google Form Link. Applicant must fill up the Form fully & accurately and submit same.
- Refund process initiation date will be considered from the date of receipt of the accurately & fully filled up Refund Request Form.
- Refund process may take up to 30 working days from the date of receipt of fully and accurately filled up Refund Request Form.
- Refunds will be made ONLY to the accounts from which the Fee payments are received.

Once the Google Form is mailed in response to Request for Withdrawal, the refund process cannot be reversed. The seat is immediately cancelled and offered to the next eligible candidate in the shortlist.






Scholarships at SNU Chennai
